

FACT SHEET

- Waterfront Rotary Club is part of Rotary International, a global network of neighbours, friends, leaders, and problem-solvers who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.
- Rotary International was founded by Paul Harris in Chicago on 23 February 1905.
- Rotarians are *People of Action*. There are 1.2 million members in 33 000 clubs in over 200 countries world-wide.
- The Waterfront Rotary Club was chartered in September 1992 and is one of the larger clubs in Rotary District 9350 with 37 members.
- Waterfront Rotary club is run by an experienced team of professionals who volunteer their services and are active in our communities ensuring that 100% of all funds donated are received by projects.
- In the last Rotary year, Waterfront Rotary undertook 38 projects, a mix of once-off and long-term projects.
- 33 of the 57 Rotary clubs in District 9350 spent over R32 million on community projects that impacted the lives of over 70 000 people last year.
- Our Rotary theme this year is “Be the Inspiration”. We could not have asked for a better ‘fit’ or a more appropriate logo for the year we are planning to host the **Waterfront Canal Challenge**, to shine the spotlight firmly on plastic pollution and saving our Oceans “one wave at a time.
